

Higham's Wood, thence proceeding along the centre of the last-mentioned footpath to Pock Hill Lane, thence proceeding across Pock Hill Lane and in a north-easterly and easterly direction along the centre of the footpath crossing the field lying to the north of Higham's Wood and leading to the eastern boundary of the said Parish of Forest Row at the south of Paupersdale Wood (hereinafter referred to as "the added area").

2. To authorise the Council to exercise within the added area all powers usually conferred upon distributors of electrical energy.

3. To authorise the Council to break up certain streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority within the added area.
