**T**HE Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees as a Local Authority who are operating an omnibus undertaking under the provisions of the Stockton-on-Tees Corporation Act, 1919, and the Stockton-on-Tees Corporation (General Powers) Act, 1930, hereby make application for the consent of the Northern Area Traffic Commissioners to their running public service
