NOTE.—The following diseases were eradicated in Great Britain :—Rinderpest (*Pestis Bovina*) in 1877 ; Pleuro-Pneumonia (*peripneumonia contagiosa bovim*) in 1898, Sheep Pox (*variola ovium*) in 1850 ; Rabies in 1922 ; Epizootic Lymphangitis (*lymphangitis epizootica*) in 1906 ; and Glanders (including Farcy) (*Malleus*) in 1928. Dourine has never existed in Great Britain.
