River Welland Catchment Area.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the River Welland

Catchment Board have made application under sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, that the approved map of the Catchment Area be varied so far as relates to the extent of the main river, by removing from the watercourses which are for the purposes of Part II of the said Act to be deemed part of the main river the watercourse known as the New River situated in the Crowland and Cowbit Washes and extending from its commencement in the Parish of Crowland to the Sluice into the River Welland in the Parish of Spalding.
