

7. To authorise the Company to hold and use for the purposes of their undertaking the lands hereinafter described and on those lands to maintain, erect, alter, improve, extend, renew and use or discontinue gas works, machinery and apparatus and to make and store gas and work up and convert the residual products of gas. The lands above referred to are the lands at Elsecar in the urban district of Hoyland Nether on which the existing gas works of the Elsecar Company are situate, viz. :—

(A) A piece of land containing 1 rood 27 perches 8 square yards or thereabouts situate and bounded on or towards the north-west by Wath Road on or towards the north and north-east by land belonging or reputed to belong to the London and North Eastern Railway Company and on or towards the south-east and south-west by land belonging or reputed to belong to Earl Fitzwilliam.

(B) A piece of land containing 1 rood 8 perches 12 square yards or thereabouts and bounded on or towards the south-east by Wath Road and on or towards the north, north-west and south-west by land belonging or reputed to belong to Earl Fitzwilliam.

8. To authorise the Company to continue, maintain and use any mains, pipes and other works of the Elsecar Company to be transferred to and vested in the Company by the intended Order (whether situate within the Elsecar limits or the Blacker Hill area or elsewhere) and to extend and apply to such mains, pipes and works the provisions of the existing Acts with such exceptions and modifications as may be defined in the Order.

9. To make temporary provision (during such period as the Order may prescribe) with respect to the calorific value, pressure and testing and the prices to be charged for gas supplied by the Company within and for gas meters within the Elsecar limits and the Blacker Hill area and during the said temporary period to relieve the Company from some or all of their obligations with respect to the matters aforesaid under the existing Acts and the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 and 1929, and also to provide that the price charged during such temporary period for gas supplied by the Company in the Elsecar limits and Blacker Hill area shall not be taken into account in determining the dividends payable by the Company.

10. To prescribe the basic price for gas supplied by the Company after such temporary period within the Elsecar limits and the Blacker Hill area. To authorise the Company to

charge differential prices for gas so supplied and to provide for the revision of such basic price.

11. To increase the annual contributions which may be made by the Company to, and the aggregate amount of, the depreciation fund authorised to be formed by the Company by section 4 of the Sheffield Gas Act, 1931.

12. To extend the powers of the Company of entering premises of consumers.

13. To incorporate with the intended Order the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Acts with modifications and exceptions and to exempt the Company from some of the provisions of those Acts. To enact all and such other provisions as may be expedient for effecting the purposes of the Order and to amend or repeal or incorporate with the Order any provisions of the existing Acts relating to any of the matters aforesaid.

Any local or other public authority, company, or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the 1st day of January, 1932. Any such objection must state (a) the specific grounds of objection and (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for, and a copy thereof must at the same time be forwarded to the undermentioned Solicitors or Parliamentary Agents.

A copy of the draft Order, an Ordnance Map showing the situation of the existing works of the Company and the Elsecar Company, the boundaries of the areas of supply of the Company and the Elsecar Company and the Blacker Hill area and an Ordnance Map showing the lands referred to in paragraph 7 of this Notice have been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Company, viz., Commercial Street, Sheffield, and at the offices of the respective Clerks of the Peace for the West Riding of the County of York, the County of Derby, the City of Sheffield and the County Borough of Rotherham.
