## COUNTY BOROUGH OF SUNDERLAND.

### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

**N**OTICE is hereby given that in pursuance of Part V of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, application has been made by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Sunderland to the Traffic Commissioners of the Northern Traffic Area for consent to run public service vehicles on the following route, that is to say:—

From the borough boundary at Southwick to North Hylton in the Rural District of Sunderland by way of North Hylton Road, Dene Road, High Street, East View and Brown Road to a terminal point at the junction of Brown Road and Ferryboat Lane.

Every objection by any local authority, county council or persons already providing similar transport facilities in the same neighbourhood must be in writing and must state the grounds on which it is based. Every such objection must be sent in triplicate to the Traffic Commissioners for the Northern Area, 41-45, Grey Street, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, so as to reach them not later than the 8th day of January, 1932.

A copy of every such objection must at the same time be sent to the undersigned.
