PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Parish of Manchester Division Act, 1850, that is to say, the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 41, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme bearing date the 10th day of December, 1931, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Parish of Manchester Division Act, 1850, that is to say, the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 41, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for setting out and constituting a separate District for

spiritual purposes and annexing such District to the consecrated Church of Saint Chad, Moston, situate within the limits of the Parish (sometime a District under the said Parish of Manchester Division Act, 1850) of Saint Mary, Moston, within the original limits of the Parish of Manchester, in the County of Lancaster and in the Diocese of Manchester:

“Whereas it appears to us to be expedient that a District for spiritual purposes comprising a part of the said Parish of Saint Mary, Moston, shall be set out and constituted for and annexed to the said Church of Saint Chad, Moston, which Church was not consecrated under the provisions of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37:

“Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Guy, Bishop of the said Diocese of Manchester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all that part of the said Parish of Saint Mary, Moston, which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth on the Map or Plan hereunto annexed shall upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the
