VARIATION OF MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

The Retail Bespoke Tailoring Trade Board (England and Wales) have issued, in respect of all Areas within the jurisdiction of the Trade Board, Notices dated 11th January, 1932, setting out Minimum Rates of Wages as varied by the Trade Board for certain classes of Male and Female Workers together with the Minimum Rates previously in operation which are unaffected by the variation. The variation of Minimum Rates has been confirmed by Order of the Minister of Labour, to take effect as from 15th January, 1932.
