

TREASURY MINUTE DATED THE 28TH
JANUARY, 1932.

My Lords read Section 8 of the Currency and Bank Notes Act 1928.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer informs the Board that the Governor and Company of the Bank of England have represented to him that it is in their opinion expedient that the amount of the fiduciary note issue be maintained at 275 million pounds, to which it was increased under the authority of Treasury Minute dated the 1st August, 1931, and subsequent Minutes concluding with the Minute of the 14th December, 1931. He proposes accordingly that the authority to the Bank to issue fiduciary bank notes to the total amount of 275 million pounds should be further extended until the 30th April, 1932.

My Lords approve and direct that the Bank of England be notified accordingly.

Let a copy of this Minute be laid before both Houses of Parliament under Section 8 sub-section (3) of the Currency and Bank Notes Act 1928.

Windley and Company Limited, Robin Hood Street, Nottingham, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable accommodation for clothing put off during working hours, mess-room accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided.
