LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF AN ORDER BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has settled and made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a scheme submitted by the River Roding Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (a) of the above Act, for the transfer to the Catchment Board of all rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities over or in connection with the main river as were immediately before the commencement of the said Act vested in or to be discharged by any drainage authority, and of any property held by the authority for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so transferred.
