

CANCELLATION OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places:—

CANCELLATIONS.

AT STRAND, EAST OF WELLINGTON STREET.	<p>Thirteen Hackney Carriages.</p> <p>In the centre of the roadway of the Strand, commencing East of the refuge opposite No. 140, Strand, and continued Eastward.</p> <p>Horses' heads Westward.</p> <p>NOTE.—The Standing will not be available for Hackney Carriages between the hours of 10 p.m. and 12 night on account of Theatre Traffic.</p>
22nd December, 1931.	
AT ALDWYCH. <i>In four portions.</i>	<p>Thirty-four Hackney Carriages.</p> <p><i>First Portion.</i>—Five carriages in centre of roadway, commencing immediately in front of the refuge opposite Aldwych Theatre, extending Eastward as far as necessary.</p> <p>Front of vehicles toward the West.</p> <p><i>Second Portion.</i>—Seven carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at South-east corner of Drury Lane and extending to the South-west corner of Kingsway.</p> <p>Front of vehicles toward the West.</p> <p><i>Third Portion.</i>—Six carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at South-east corner of Kingsway, extending to South-west corner of Houghton Street.</p> <p>Front of vehicles toward the West.</p> <p><i>Fourth Portion.</i>—Sixteen carriages in centre of roadway commencing at South-east corner of Houghton Street and extending Eastward as far as necessary.</p> <p>Front of vehicles toward the West.</p> <p>NOTE.—The fourth portion will only be available after 8 p.m.</p> <p>The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, the second portion from the third and the third from the fourth portion.</p>
22nd December, 1931.	
AT STRAND, WEST OF WELLINGTON STREET.	<p>Three Hackney Carriages.</p> <p>In the centre of the roadway of the Strand, commencing immediately behind the refuge West of Wellington Street, and extending Westwards as far as necessary.</p> <p>The first two horses' heads to face East, the other West.</p> <p>The Standing will not be available for Hackney Carriages between the hours of 10 p.m. and 12 night on account of Theatre traffic.</p>
22nd December, 1931.	
AT STRAND, W.C. <i>In two portions.</i>	<p>Three Hackney Carriages.</p> <p><i>First Portion.</i>—One carriage in the centre of roadway, West of the refuge opposite Somerset House, to stand at a point in line with the Eastern side of the Pedestrians' East Entrance to Somerset House.</p> <p>Front of vehicle toward the West.</p> <p><i>Second Portion.</i>—Two carriages in the centre of roadway, commencing two yards East of the refuge opposite Somerset House, extending Eastward as far as necessary for two carriages.</p> <p>Front of vehicles toward the West.</p> <p>The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.</p>
