SHEEP SCAB MOVEMENT AREAS.

The following Areas are now "Movement Areas" for the purposes of Part II of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928:—

1. *Inverness.*—An Area comprising:—

The islands known as the Outer Hebrides (except the Islands of *St. Kilda*, *Dune*, *Soay* and *Boreray*), in the county of Inverness.

2. *Ross and Cromarty.*—An Area comprising:—

The island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
