A PROCLAMATION REVOKING, SO FAR AS IT RELATES TO BASUTOLAND, THE PROCLAMATION OF 23RD JANUARY, 1911, APPLYING PARTS OF THE COINAGE ACT, 1870, TO THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA AND BASUTOLAND.

WHEREAS by virtue of a Proclamation of His Majesty dated the 23rd day of January, 1911 (hereinafter called "the Proclamation"), certain parts of the Coinage Act, 1870, as amended by section two and the schedule of the Coinage Act, 1891, were applied, with the modifications specified in the Proclamation to the Union of South Africa and Basutoland:

And whereas by virtue of the Coinage Act, 1870, it is lawful for Us, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to revoke any Proclamation previously made under that Act:

And whereas under an Order of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria in Council, dated the 2nd day of February, 1884, the High Commissioner for South Africa (hereinafter called "the High Commissioner") is empowered to make by Proclamation such laws as may appear to him necessary for the peace, order, and good government of Basutoland:

And whereas it is expedient that the High Commissioner should be empowered to make further provision by Proclamation respecting the currency of Basutoland, and that, in the event of such further provision being so made, the Proclamation should be revoked so far as it applies to Basutoland:

Now, therefore, We, with the advice of Our Privy Council in pursuance of the said Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby proclaim, direct, and ordain, as follows:—

1. The Proclamation shall, as from the date of the commencement of any Proclamation by the High Commissioner making further provision as to the currency of Basutoland, be revoked so far as relates to Basutoland, and accordingly the said Act shall as from that date cease to apply to and to be in force in Basutoland.
