The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Trinity College, in the University of Oxford, on the 25th day of May, 1932, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

ALTERATION OF STATUTES.

At a General Meeting specially called for the purpose of making certain amendments to the Statutes of the College, with notice of the business to be transacted thereat, and holden in Common Room on Wednesday, 25 May, 1932, present the President and all the Fellows, it was resolved by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting that the following amendments should be made, sealed, and submitted for the approval of the King in Council, namely:

(1) In Stat. II, section 2 (d), line 1, the word "Allocated" shall be inserted between the words "many" and "Professorial" and a second clause shall be added as follows:

"It shall also be in the power of the College to elect to an Additional Professorial Fellowship not more than one person, being a

Professor or Reader in the University or the holder of any University Office specified in Titulus XXVI of the University Statutes."

And in section 4 the words "Additional Professorial" shall be inserted after "Emeritus" in lines 1 and 7.

(2) In Stat. VIII, section 1, line 2, the word "Allocated" shall be inserted before the word "Professorial".
