HAT, CAP AND MILLINERY TRADE BOARD (ENGLAND AND WALES).

VARIATION OF MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE WORKERS.

The Hat, Cap and Millinery Trade Board (England and Wales) have issued a Notice H.M.(16) dated 13th July, 1932, setting out Minimum Rates of Wages for certain classes of Male Workers as varied by the Trade Board, and confirmed by Order of the Minister of Labour, to take effect as from 21st July, 1932, together with the Minimum Rates of Wages for both Male and Female Workers previously in operation which are unaffected by the variation.
