RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiration of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act, to make Regulations in regard to "one-way" traffic working at the junction of Sheen Road with Queen's Road, Richmond, Surrey.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency, the Minister of Transport has, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 4) Provisional Regulations, 1932, to come into force on the ninth day of August, 1932, as Provisional Regulations, to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Amendment (Route No. 152) Provisional Regulations, 1932, to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations, to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

These Regulations provide for the operation by the London General Omnibus Company, Limited, of a service of omnibuses on Route No. 152 (Mitcham "The Cricketers" and Tolworth "The Red Lion").
