##### LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

*River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Area.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the River Ouse (Yorks.)
