

## CANCELLATION OF STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

*By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."*

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place:—

## CANCELLATION.

AT DREWSTEAD ROAD,  
STREATHAM HILL.

Fourteen Hackney Carriages:

*First Portion.*—Two carriages on North side of roadway, commencing three yards West from foot crossing in High Road, extending Westward as far as necessary for two carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the East.

*Note.*—Of the two carriages on this portion, one shall be mechanically propelled, and the other horse drawn.

*Second Portion.*—Twelve carriages on North side of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the entrance to Stonehills Mansions, extending Westward as far as necessary for twelve carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the East.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz.:—

## APPOINTMENTS.

AT DREWSTEAD ROAD,  
STREATHAM HILL.

Twenty Hackney Carriages:

*First Portion.*—Two carriages on North side of roadway, commencing in line with a point three yards West from the Western building line of High Road (South-east corner of Drewstead Road), extending Westward, by kerb, as far as necessary for two carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the East.

*Second Portion.*—Eighteen carriages on North side of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the entrance to Stonehills Mansions, extending Westward, by kerb, as far as necessary for eighteen carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the East.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

Three Hackney Carriages:

On East side of roadway, commencing at a point ten yards North of the building line of High Street, extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.
