## TEES VALLEY WATER BOARD.

Whereas the Tees Valley Water Board (hereinafter called the Board) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Section 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Tees Valley Water Act, 1930, so as:—

(1) to extend the time limited by Section 20 of the said Local Act for the compulsory purchase of the lands and the easements in lands which the Board are by Sections 5 and 14 of the said Local Act authorised to acquire but have not yet acquired for and in connexion with the construction of certain works authorised by Section 5 of the said Local Act, that is to say, as to the lands and easements in lands required for and in connexion with Works Nos. 1 and 4 (Conduits Nos. 15 and 18), until the first day of October, 1940; and as to the lands and easements in lands required for and in connexion with the remaining Works, until the first day of October, 1938;

(2) to extend the time limited by Section 21 of the said Local Act for the completion of the said Works until the first day of October, 1945;

(3) for the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act in force within the limits within which the Board are authorised to supply water as may be necessary or desirable;

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that G. M. McNaughton, Esq., A.M.Inst.C.E., A.M.I. Mech.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough, on Tuesday, the twenty-second day of November, 1932, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into

the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

## MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, has made the Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) Order (No. 6), 1932, to come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1932.

The Order authorises the drawing on roads by motor vehicles of aircraft, the overall length of which does not exceed 30 ft., and the weight of which does not exceed one ton, notwithstanding that such aircraft do not comply with the requirements of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations, 1931.

## SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT, 1923.

## TEIFY AND AYRON FISHERY DISTRICTS.

*To Owners and Lessees of Fisheries, Salmon, Trout and Freshwater Fish Licensees, and other persons interested.*
