RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiry of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations varying the provisions of the First Schedule to the said Act of 1930 in such manner as to provide that no speed limit shall be imposed on certain vehicles the property or for the time being under the control of the Admiralty or the War Department which said vehicles are more particularly specified in the said Regulations.

Copies of the draft Regulations the title of which is "The Motor Vehicles (Armed Forces) Variation of Speed Limit Regulations," can be obtained by any public or representative body on application to the Assistant Secretary, Roads Department, Ministry of Transport, 7, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1, to whom any observations or suggestions in connection with the draft Regulations should be sent in writing.
