

be payable only upon the production to us on or after each of the said last mentioned quarterly days of payment of a certificate (in such form as may be required by us) under the hand of the Bishop of the Diocese in which the Benefice is situate certifying that during the quarter then ended, there has been employed within the Parish of the Benefice and duly licensed by such Bishop such number of Assistant Curates as is stated in the eighth column of the said Schedule, and that the last in order of such number of Assistant Curates has been in receipt of a stipend after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum. Provided also that the yearly sum or stipend so granted shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be ex-

pedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the Parish and Benefice in favour of which it is granted. Provided further that such yearly sum or stipend is granted upon and is payable only subject to satisfaction of the further conditions (if any) stated with reference thereto at the foot of the said Schedule. Provided lastly that this Instrument which is intended to be executed in several parts (one part for each Diocese concerned) shall operate only as a single Grant in favour of each of the Benefices mentioned in the said Schedule.
