said Schedule opposite to the name of the Benefice, and such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of three pounds per centum per annum commencing from the date stated in the sixth column of the said Schedule opposite to the name of the Benefice. Provided that this Instrument which is intended to be executed in several parts (one part for each Diocese concerned) shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the Benefices mentioned in the said Schedule.
