The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts, of women of 18 and young persons of 16 years of age and over in the electric cable and wire department at the works of The India Rubber, Gutta Percha and Telegraph Works Company Limited, North Woolwich Road, Silvertown, E.16, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable accommodation for clothing put off during working hours and messroom accommodation shall be provided.

SUNDAY ENTERTAINMENTS ACT, 1932.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that the Secretary of State for the Home Department intends, after the expiration of 40 days from this date, to make Regulations under the Sunday Entertainments Act, 1932, prescribing the percentage for the purposes of the Act, and the times at which and the manner in which licensing authorities shall transmit to the Privy Council the sums paid to them as contributions to the Cinematograph Fund.

The prescribed percentage is five per cent. and the sums paid to licensing authorities are to be transmitted quarterly by them to the Privy Council.

THE CORONERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1926.

ORDER FOR THE ALTERATION OF CORONERS' DISTRICTS.

Whereas on the twenty-seventh day of July, 1932, the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster under his hand and seal on behalf of His Majesty relinquished, pursuant to Section 4 (3) of the Coroners (Amendment) Act, 1926, the power of appointing a Franchise Coroner for the Duchy of Lancaster Liberty in the County of Middlesex;

And whereas on the ninth day of August, 1932, a vacancy occurred in the Office of Franchise Coroner for the said Liberty;

And whereas by the operation of Section 4 of the said Act, the area over which the Franchise Coroner for the said Liberty had jurisdiction thereupon became merged in the County of Middlesex for all purposes relating to Coroners;

And whereas the County of Middlesex is at present divided into two Coroners' Districts, and it is necessary to alter the existing division of the County so as to include the said Liberty in one of such districts;

And whereas the Middlesex County Council have pursuant to Section 12 of the said Act and to the Coroners (Orders as to Districts) Rules, 1927, submitted to the Secretary of State a draft Order providing for the alteration of the existing division of the County of Middlesex into Coroners' districts so as to include in one of those districts the area of the said Liberty;

Now therefore, I, the undersigned, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the power vested in me by Section 12 of the Coroners (Amendment) Act, 1926, do hereby order that the existing division of the County of Middlesex into Coroners' districts, shall be altered and that the said districts shall be named and constituted as set out in the Schedule hereto and substituted for the existing districts.

This Order shall come into operation on the first day of December, 1932.
