HEREFORD.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Hereford (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Authority for the said City, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Hereford Improvement Act, 1854 so as:—

(1) to enable the Corporation to demand and take from any person slaughtering cattle in any slaughter-house belonging to the Corporation such tolls as the Corporation may from time to time with the approval of the Minister of Health prescribe;

(2) for the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with,

incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said City as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application and that in order to give effect to the purposes of the Application such Provisional Order should provide that any slaughter-house belonging to the Corporation shall be deemed to have been provided by them under the powers of the Public Health Act, 1875 and that the provisions of that Act shall apply in respect of such slaughter-house accordingly;

Notice is hereby given that T. H. Sheepshanks, Esq., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Town Hall, Hereford, on Tuesday, the thirty-first day of January, 1933, at half-past ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
