FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1933 (No. 6).

SUBJECT.

Declares the following to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925:—
