The KING has been pleased, by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Realm, bearing date the 24th instant, to confer the dignity of a Viscount of the United Kingdom upon the Right Honourable Stanley Owen, Baron Buckmaster, G.C.V.O., and the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten, by the name, style and title of **VISCOUNT BUCKMASTER** of Cheddington in the County of Buckingham.
