#### MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

##### THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE NORTH RIDING OF YORKSHIRE.

##### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

**W**HEREAS in pursuance of Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, the County Council of the North Riding of Yorkshire have made application to the Minister of Transport for an Order to be made by him, the effect of which is:—

To prohibit, subject to such exceptions or conditions as to occasional user or otherwise, as may be specified in the Order, the driving of heavy and light locomotives, motor tractors and heavy motor cars (as defined respectively by Section 2 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930) on the whole of the road between Waithwith Bank Plantation and Vicars Green at Hudswell known as Green Lane in the Townships of Hudswell and Hipswell and the whole of the road between Berry House and Badger Beck Plantation known as Middlemoor Lane in the Township of Hudswell.

Provided that nothing in the Order shall prevent the driving upon the said roads of any vehicle which is being used:—

(i) for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any house, building or other premises situate on or adjacent to the said roads:

(ii) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads, or the laying, alteration or repair in or near to the said roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports; and

(iii) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjoining or lying near to the said roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land.

Notice is hereby given that T. Knight, Esq., A.M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Transport, will attend at the Town Hall, Richmond, Yorkshire, on Tuesday, the fourth day of April, 1933, at 11.30 o'clock in the forenoon, to hold an Inquiry into the subject matter of the application.

And notice is hereby further given that all persons interested who, within one week from the twenty-fifth day of March next, send notice in writing of their desire to be heard at the Inquiry to the Minister of Transport, 7, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1, shall be entitled to appear and be heard either in person or by Counsel, Agent or Solicitor.

In Parliament.—Session 1932-33.

#### LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL (MONEY).

**T**HE London County Council intend to apply to Parliament in the present Session for leave to bring in a Bill (hereinafter referred to as "the Bill") under the short title of "London County Council (Money)," the title of the Bill being "A Bill to regulate the expenditure on capital account and lending of money by the London County Council during the financial period from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, to the thirtieth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and for other purposes."

A notice containing a concise summary of the purposes of the Bill has been or will be published in full in "The Times" newspaper on the 22nd and 29th days of March, 1933.

Printed copies of the Bill will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons, in accordance with the provisions of the Standing Orders, on or before the first day on which that House re-assembles after the Easter Recess, and on and after that day a copy of the Bill may be inspected and copies thereof may be obtained at the price of one shilling each at the offices of the undersigned Parliamentary Officer and Parliamentary Agents.
