as appears to them to be suitable; and the Secretary of State after taking into consideration any objections to the Draft Order made in the prescribed manner and within the prescribed time, may make the Order, either in the terms of the draft submitted to him or with such modification as he thinks fit:

And whereas the County Council for the Administrative County of Dorset having decided that it is expedient that the Parishes of Bourton, Gillingham and Motcomb, com-prising the Liberty of Gillingham, shall be merged in and form part of the Northern Coroner's District as constituted by the said Order in Council of the 26th day of August, 1893, and subsequently amended, have submitted to me a Draft Order for the alteration of the Northern Coroner's District pursuant to Section 12 of the said Act:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 12 of the said Act, I hereby order that the Northern Coroner's District shall be altered and constituted so as to consist of the following parishes :—
