

(7) As to each envelope bearing the serial number and received on or before the said day the Scrutineers shall ascertain by reference to the Voters List whether the same appears to be signed by the voter whose serial number it bears and they shall destroy unopened any such envelope which is not received on or before the said day or which does not appear to be so signed. They shall open all the said envelopes which are received on or before the said day and appear to be so signed and shall extract the voting papers therefrom and shall count the votes thereby given for the several candidates and shall report the result to the Council.

(8) At the Annual meeting of the Council held in the ensuing month of March the Chairman presiding thereat shall declare to be elected the candidates (not exceeding the appropriate number) for whom the highest numbers of votes have been ascertained (in the manner above provided) to have been given.

(9) If an equality of votes is found to exist between any of the candidates and the addition of a vote would enable any such candidate to be declared elected the said Chairman may give such additional vote orally but if he be unwilling to give such vote he shall determine by lot which of the candidates whose votes are equal shall be elected and he shall declare the election accordingly.

(10) The candidates elected shall be entitled to retain office as members of the Council until the close of the Annual meeting thereof to be held in the month of March in the year succeeding the year of the election.
