BRUSH AND BROOM TRADE BOARD
(GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY AND TO FIX MINIMUM RATES
OF WAGES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 21st April, 1927, the Brush and Broom Trade Board (Great Britain) HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they PROPOSE TO VARY the Minimum Rates of Wages for male and female workers set out in the Notices M. (46) and M. (47) issued by the Brush and Broom Trade Board (Great Britain) and dated 31st October, 1930, and TO FIX an additional General Minimum Piece-Rate for Male Workers on Hairs, and Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates for certain classes of Male Workers in all cases for periods dependent on the "Cost of Living" Figure.

This Notice is issued with the consent of the Minister of Labour.

Particulars of the proposed variation of minimum rates and of the minimum rates proposed to be fixed may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Trade Board at the address given below.

In accordance with Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board will CONSIDER ANY OBJECTIONS to the above Proposal to Vary and to Fix which may be lodged with them within two months from the 29th day of August, 1933. Such objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her name and address) and should be sent to the Secretary, Brush and Broom Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1. It is desirable that Objections should state precisely and, so far as possible with reasons, what is objected to.
