THE BRIGHTLINGSEA (SHELL-FISH) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1933.

Notice is hereby given under Section 3 (3) of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that by the above-named Regulations dated the 29th day of August, 1933, the Minister of Health has modified the Brightlingsea (Shell-Fish) Regulations, 1932 (S.R. & O., No. 664 of 1932), so as

to postpone until the 1st day of November, 1933, the date of operation of the said Regulations, and to prohibit the sale or distribution for human consumption of oysters, mussels, or other shellfish taken from the Brightlingsea Creek extending seawards and bounded by a line drawn due South from Bateman's Tower, and a line drawn due West from the Martello Tower A on the South of the Creek, each prolonged to the point of intersection, and also its tributary creeks (including Flag Creek, Thorrington Creek, and St. Osyth Creek) and all oyster pits which are situate on or near the banks of any of the said creeks and which are flushed at any time by the water of such creeks.
