DANGEROUS DRUGS ACTS, 1920-1932.

PROVISIONAL RULES OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME DEPARTMENT, DATED SEPTEMBER 13, 1933, AMENDING REGULATION 17 OF THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATIONS, 1928 (INTERPRETATION) AND REPEALING THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (BENZOYL-MORPHINE) REGULATIONS, 1928.

In pursuance of Section 7 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. Regulation 17 (1) of the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations, 1928, S.R. & O. 1928 (No. 981), shall be amended and shall take effect as if

(i) in the definition of "Drug",

(a) the words "benzoyl-morphine or a preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing benzoyl-morphine" were omitted; and

(b) after the words "other than" there were inserted "methyilmorphine, ethyl-morphine or their respective salts"; and

(ii) in the definition of "Preparation", the words "(other than benzoyl-morphine)" were omitted.

2. Copies of the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations, 1928, printed under the authority of His Majesty's Stationery Office may be printed with the amendments directed to be made by these Regulations.

3. The Dangerous Drugs (Benzoyl-morphine) Regulations, 1928, S.R. & O. 1928 (No. 925), are hereby repealed.

4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, 52-3 V. c. 63, applies for the purpose of the construction of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the construction of an Act of Parliament.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Regulations, 1933.

In pursuance of Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, I hereby certify that on account of urgency the foregoing Regulations should come into immediate operation, and I direct that they shall come into operation forthwith as provisional rules.
