#### SCHEDULE.

The Durham District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930 (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme"), shall be amended as follows:

- 1. Clause 51 of the Scheme shall be deleted and the following new Clause 51 shall be substituted therefor:
  - "51. The Minimum price per ton of 20 cwts. fixed for each class of coal produced in the District shall be:-
    - (i) in the case of any class of coal sold or destined for shipment, a price 'f.o.b.' at the customary place of shipment:

Provided that for the purpose of fixing such minimum 'f.o.b.' price the costs charges and expenses falling to be borne or paid by an owner selling under an 'f.o.b.' contract shall be deemed to include any dues rates or tolls chargeable in respect of coal shipped at or exported from such customary place of shipment, and an owner selling coal of any class for delivery 'f.o.b.' shall accordingly be at liberty to apply so much of the price thereof as represents the amount of any such dues rates or tolls as aforesaid in paying the same for the benefit of or on behalf of the buyer of that coal or to allow or refund such amount to the buyer if the said dues rates or tolls are paid by him; and

(ii) in all other cases such price as may be fixed by the Board having regard to all the circumstances of the case:

Provided that there shall be only one minimum price for each class of coal."

2. Clause 57 of the Scheme shall be amended as follows:--

After the words "incurred subsequent to shipment" in line 5 of the Clause there shall be inserted the words "(not being dues rates or tolls to which the proviso to subparagraph (i) of Clause 51 applies) ".
