

port, dated the 13th day of November, 1933, in the following terms:—

Whereas by paragraph eleven of Part I of the Eleventh Schedule to the Local Government Act, 1929, if it appears to the Minister of Transport that by reason of some exceptional occurrence the net revenue of the Freight Rebates Fund for any year is or will be abnormally greater or less than the amount which upon the basis of the rebates for the time being in force will be required to pay the sums payable thereout under paragraph five of the said Part of the said Schedule to the railway companies in respect of that year and that there is danger of such instability being occasioned in the rates of the said rebates as to affect prejudicially the operation of the Scheme, the Minister of Transport is required to issue to the Railway Rates Tribunal a certificate that in his opinion the rates of the rebates to be allowed in respect of any group of selected traffics specified in the certificate ought to be reviewed.

And whereas the present abnormal conditions of trade and the difficulty in forecasting the extent to which selected traffics will be conveyed by railway in the near future constitute in the opinion of the Minister an exceptional occurrence and that there is danger of such instability as aforesaid being thereby occasioned.

Now therefore, the Minister of Transport, in pursuance of paragraph eleven of Part I of the said Schedule hereby certifies that in his

opinion the rates of the rebates to be allowed in respect of all the groups of selected traffics specified in Parts II, III and IV of the said Schedule ought to be reviewed.
