ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS 1882 to 1933.

NEWCASTLE-UNDER-LYME ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER 1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Borough of Newcastle-under-Lyme of electricity within so much of the said borough as immediately prior to the coming into operation of the Borough of Newcastle-under-Lyme (Extension) Order 1931 formed the urban district of Wolstanton United part of the urban district of Audley and the parish of Clayton and part of the

parish of Keele in the rural district of Newcastle-under-Lyme in the County of Stafford.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1931, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1, and posted not later than the 20th March, 1934. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Town Clerk, Newcastle-under-Lyme and at the office of the Education Committee of the Corporation, Moreton House, Wolstanton, Newcastle-under-Lyme.
