

FACTORY AND WORKSHOP ACTS,  
1901 TO 1929.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice, in pursuance of Section 86 (1) of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, that on the 27th February, 1934, he made a Regulation, under Section 79 of the said Act, amending exemption (ii) of the Horizontal Milling Machines Regulations, 1928.

The Regulation, which comes into force on the 1st April, 1934, and which is in accordance with the draft issued on the 23rd January last, may be cited as the Horizontal Milling Machines (Amendment) Regulation, 1934, and the Horizontal Milling Machines Regulations, 1928, as amended by this Regulation may be cited as the Horizontal Milling Machines Regulations.
