Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a scheme submitted to him by the Witham and Steeping Rivers Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the abolition of certain Drainage Districts and the Drainage Boards thereof, the constitution of the Witham Fifth District Internal Drainage District, and certain matters supplemental thereto: and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice a Memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected by the Order, and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a Memorial.
