"3. That upon the day when any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme shall be published in the London Gazette the unions shall forthwith take effect and the said Edward George Augustine Gardener if he is then Incumbent of the said Benefice of Fen Drayton shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice of Fen Drayton with Conington and the said Lawrence Iggulden if he is then Incumbent of the said Benefice of Elsworth shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice of Elsworth with Knapwell.

"4. That upon the said unions taking effect (a) the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Fen Drayton shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Fen Drayton with Conington (b) the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Elsworth shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Elsworth with Knapwell and (c) so soon as conveniently may be the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Conington with Knapwell and the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds heretofore usually occupied and enjoyed therewith shall be sold and disposed of by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient and that the net proceeds of such sale or such part thereof as to us and to the Bishop of Ely shall seem expedient shall be appropriated towards the cost of repairing and improving the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Fen Drayton and any balance of such net proceeds shall be held and invested by us for the benefit of the United Benefice of Fen Drayton with Conington.

"5. That after the said unions have taken effect the course and succession in which the respective Patrons shall present or nominate to the United Benefices from time to time as the same shall become vacant shall be as follows, that is to say (a) the right of presentation to the United Benefice of Fen Drayton with Conington shall be exercised by the Patrons of the said Benefices of Fen Drayton and Conington withKnapwell alternately, the Patron of the said Benefice of Conington with Knapwell having the right upon the first presentation to such United Benefice to be made after the union and every alternate right of presentation and the Patrons of the said Benefice of Fen Drayton having the right of presentation upon the second presentation to the same United Benefice to be made after the union and every alternate turn thereafter, and (b) in every series of five successive turns of presentation or nomination to be made to the United Benefice of Elsworth with Knapwell after the unions the Patron of the said Benefice of Elsworth shall have the first, the third, the fourth and the fifth turns and the Patron of the said Benefice of Conington with Knapwell shall have the second turn.

"6. That upon the unions taking effect (a) a part of the endowments and property belonging to the said United Benefices of Conington with Knapwell, namely all glebe land belonging to such United Benefice which is situate within the Parish of Conington and

a sum of £7,122 19s. 2d. Local Loans £3 per cent. per annum Stock at present held by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners on behalf of the said United Benefice of Conington with Knapwell shall be transferred and annexed to the United Benefice of Fen Drayton with Conington, and (b) all other endowments and property belonging to the said United Benefice of Conington with Knapwell (except the Parsonage House hereinbefore directed to be sold) shall be transferred and annexed to the United Benefice of Elsworth with Knapwell.

"Provided always that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Measure, or of any other Measure of the National Assembly of the Church of England, or of any Act of Parliament."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the same Measure to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules applicable to proceedings under the said Union of Benefices Measure, 1923:

And whereas certain objections have been so stated or transmitted to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the same Rules:

And whereas the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners after giving full consideration to such objections have deemed right to make no alterations in such draft Scheme:

And whereas public notice of the certification to His Majesty in Council of the said Scheme and the consent thereto in writing of the Bishop of Ely has been duly given in the manner and within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules aforesaid:

And whereas an appeal against the said Scheme has been made to His Majesty in Council by the Churchwardens of Fen Drayton, and such appeal was referred to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council by Order in Council of the 19th day of April, 1933:

And whereas the Lords of the said Committee, having taken the said appeal into consideration, reported to His Majesty in Council their opinion that the appeal ought to be dismissed and the said Scheme be affirmed:

And whereas His Majesty was pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council by Order of the 26th day of February, 1934, to approve the said Report:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to affirm the said Scheme and to order that the Benefices therein recommended to be united shall be united to the extent and for the purposes recommended in the said Scheme, and further to order and direct that the said Scheme and every part thereof shall be
