

between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon. (3) Any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area and any association representing owners of property within the Urban District of Harrow-on-the-Hill and any local association representing business or industry may, by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Urban District Council of Harrow-on-the-Hill to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme;

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933 (on sale—obtainable (price 2d.) from His Majesty's Stationery Office, Adastral House, Kingsway, W.C.2, or through any bookseller) the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Urban District Council of Harrow-on-the-Hill are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited, together with the aforesaid Map.

The Urban District Council of Harrow-on-the-Hill intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Clerk to the Council.

In Parliament.—Session 1933-34.

#### LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL (MONEY).

THE London County Council intend to apply to Parliament in the present Session for leave to bring in a Bill (hereinafter referred to as "the Bill") under the short title of "London County Council (Money)", the title of the Bill being "A Bill to regulate the expenditure on capital account and lending of money by the London County Council during the financial period from the first day of April one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four to the thirtieth day of September one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five and for other purposes".

A notice containing a concise summary of the purposes of the Bill has been or will be published in full in "The Times" newspaper on the 22nd and 29th days of March, 1934.

Printed copies of the Bill will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons, in accordance with the provisions of the Standing Orders, on or before the 14th day of April, 1934, or the first day on which that House re-assembles after the Easter Recess, whichever is the later, and on and after the date of such deposit a copy of the Bill may be inspected and copies thereof may be obtained at the price of one shilling each at the offices of the undersigned Parliamentary Officer and Parliamentary Agents.
