MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE.

With reference to the notices which were published in certain issues of the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes regarding references made by the Board of Trade to the Standing Committee under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, namely:—

(1) in the issue of the London and Edinburgh Gazettes of the 28th July, 1931, and in the Belfast Gazette of the 31st July, 1931, in respect of imported metal spools for typewriter, adding machine and calculating machine ribbons;

(2) in the issue of the said Gazettes of the 5th May, 1933, in respect of imported parts of metal spools for typewriter, adding machine and calculating machine ribbons; the Board of Trade hereby give notice, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2, Sub-section 7, that a Report has been made by the Committee in respect of the aforesaid descriptions of goods.
