That part of the parish of Drymen that lies to the west of the public road which passes Balfunning House and which runs from the bridge over the Kelty Water at Wester Third to Drymen bridge over the River Endrick.

In the county of Dunbarton.

The premises known respectively as Ardleigh Farm and Doune Farm in the parish of Arrochar.

In the county of Perth.

That part of the parish of Aberfoyle (including the premises in the occupation of the Glasgow Corporation known as Stronachlachar Farm and the premises known as Frenich Farm) which lies to the south and west of a line drawn from the point where the eastern boundary of Stronachlachar Farm joins Loch Katrine along the eastern boundary of the said Stronachlachar Farm; thence along the eastern boundary of Frenich Farm; thence along the western shore of Loch Chon; thence along the River Chon; thence along the southern shore of Loch Ard; thence along the River Forth to the point where it crosses the parish boundary near Gartmore Station.

That part of the parish of Port of Menteith that lies to the west of the road that runs from Gartmore Station to the Bridge over the Kelty Water at Wester Third.
