

## WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1925.

## INDUSTRIAL DISEASES.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that on the 28th May, 1934, he made an Order under Section 43 of the above Act. The effect of the Order, which will come into force on the 1st July, 1934, is to add to the Schedule of Industrial Diseases under that Act, "poisoning by diethylene dioxide (dioxan), or its sequelae".

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts, of women of eighteen years of age and over in glass examining, washing, ticketing and packing in the warehouse departments at the Gerrards Bridge works of Messrs. Pilkington Brothers Limited, Cowley Hill, St. Helens, Lancashire, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable cloakroom and mess-room accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided.
