The following Statute made by the Governing Body of New College, Oxford, on the 2nd day of May, 1934, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO STATUTE III, 14, OF THE STATUTES OF NEW COLLEGE, OXFORD, APPROVED BY RESOLUTION OF THE WARDEN AND FELLOWS BY THE UNANIMOUS VOTE OF ALL THOSE PRESENT AND VOTING AT A MEETING SPECIALLY SUMMONED FOR THE PURPOSE, AND HELD CN MAX 2ND, 1934.

In Statute III, 14, of the College Statutes add at the end the following words:

"unless the Warden and Fellows at any Stated General Meeting shall have resolved that for a period not exceeding the ensuing twelve months four will suffice: Provided that the pernoctation of several such Fellows in turn during any period may, if so permitted by any Bylaw respecting the residence of Fellows, be treated as equivalent to

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the residence during that period of the same Fellow."
