

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts, of women of 18 years of age and over in dry cleaning (by Burtol plant), pressing and ironing at the works of Quickest Dry Cleaners Limited, 17, Victoria Place, Eastbourne, subject to the conditions that, apart from any arrangements that may be made to meet the convenience of individual workers, a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable accommodation for clothing put off during working hours, mess-room accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided.
