The Minister of Transport has received an application from the National Joint Conciliation Board for the Road Motor Transport Industry (Goods), being an organisation representative of employers and workpeople in the section of the road transport industry concerned with the conveyance of goods by road, which the Minister of Labour has certified to be a proper body to make such an application, for a variation of the periods of time laid down in Section 19 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended by Section 31 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933, for the employment of drivers of road vehicles of certain types.

As provided in sub-section (3) of Section 19 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the Minister has referred the matter to the Industrial Court for advice. The Court has fixed Tuesday, 18th September, 1934, at 10.30 a.m., at 5, Old Palace Yard, Westminster, S.W.1, as the time and place for hearing parties to the application.

Copies of the proposals contained in the application for the variation of the periods of time laid down in Section 19 of the Act can be obtained from the Secretary of the Industrial Court at the address given above, and any person representing organisations of employers or workpeople in the industry who may desire to make representations to the Court in the matter, should submit such representations to the Secretary in writing.
