WORKSOP ELECTRIC LIGHTING ORDER 1899.

WORKSOP ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER 1930.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Worksop for the consent of the Commissioners under Section 11 of the Electricity Supply Act 1919 to establish a generating station for the purposes of the above named Order and Special Order on a piece of land containing approximately twenty-three acres and situate on the south-westerly side of the Manton Colliery of the Wigan Coal Corporation at Worksop.

A plan showing the land in question together with a plan and an elevation drawing of the generating station and a description of the machinery proposed to be installed therein has been deposited for public inspection at the Office of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Worksop.

If any Body, established in the Electricity District, or any owner or lessee of property situate within three hundred yards of the proposed site wish to state objections to the application, they must do so by registered letter, addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C.2, within thirty days from the date hereof, and a copy of the objection must be addressed to me.

PROPOSED ALTERATION OF COUNTY BOUNDARIES, 1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Councils for the administrative Counties of Chester and Derby have, by Memorial dated the twenty-fifth day of August, 1934, made proposals to the Minister of Health, in accordance with Section 140 of the Local Government Act, 1933, that it is desirable that the boundaries of the Administrative Counties of Chester and Derby should be altered by transferring the portions of the Parishes of Taxal and Kettlethulme, the portion of the Urban District of Yeardsley-cum-Whaley, and the portions of the Rural District and Parish of Disley, situate within the Administrative County of Chester, and numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 respectively on the map marked "A" accompanying the Proposals, from the County of Chester to the County of Derby; and by transferring the portion of the Urban District of New Mills and the Parishes of Ludworth and Mellor, situate within the Administrative County of Derby, and numbered 6, 7, and 8 respectively on the said map, from the County of Derby to the County of Chester; and also as consequential on the alteration of the County boundaries that it is desirable to make the necessary alterations in the areas of the Urban and Rural Districts and Parishes as are more particularly described in the said Proposals.

Notice is also given that a copy of the said Proposals and a duplicate of the maps, A, B, and B (Supplemental) accompanying the Proposals, have been deposited on the date hereof at the Office of the Clerk of the Cheshire County Council, County Offices, Chester, and at the Office of the Clerk of the Derbyshire County Council, County Offices, Derby, and will be there open to inspection during the usual office hours, without payment, by any local authority having jurisdiction within the areas, or by any person affected by the Proposal.
