**TOWN PLANNING SCHEME.**

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1932.

**N**OTICE is hereby given that (1) on the ninth day of October, 1934, the Minister of Health notified his approval of the resolution of the Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas Urban District Council dated the 29th day of August, 1934, deciding to prepare the above planning scheme with reference to an area situate wholly within the Urban District of Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas; (2) a certified copy of the Map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the Council Rooms, Thurstonland, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without charge between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.; (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area and any association representing owners of property within the Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas Urban District and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in

writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas Urban District Council to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme;

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,\* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas Urban District Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.
