(e) The grant will be subject to variation or withdrawal at the discretion of the Commissioners in the event of any powers of the Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, as extended by the Pluralities Measure, 1930, in relation to Union or otherwise being exercised in a manner to affect this Benefice.
