At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 9th day of November, 1934.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Minister of Health, after giving to the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of Catshill, in the County of Worcester, 10 days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has under the provisions of the Burial Act, 1853, as amended by subsequent enactments, made a Representation to His Majesty in Council that for the protection of the public health burials should be discontinued as follows, viz.:—

Catshill.—Forthwith and entirely in the Parish Church of Catshill, in the Civil Parish of Bromsgrove, and in the Old Churchyard attached thereto.

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give Notice of such Representation and to order that the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on the 20th day of December next.

And His Majesty is further pleased to direct that this Order be forthwith published in the London Gazette, and that copies thereof be affixed on the doors of the Churches or Chapels of, or on some conspicuous places within, the Parish affected by such Representation one month before the said 20th day of December.
