And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly hereinbefore mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such Scheme to be constituted shall be taken, and such Patrons and Incumbents have with the exception hereinafter mentioned respectively signified their assent to such Scheme:

And whereas one of the Patrons of the Vicarage of the said Parish of St. John, Coventry, has not signified his assent to the said Scheme:

And whereas a period of more than one calendar month has elapsed since drafts of the said Scheme were transmitted to the said Patrons and Incumbents:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Coventry.
